The San Francisco Hep B Free Campaign wants to make San Francisco the 1st city in the U.S. to test and vaccinate all Asian and Pacific Islander adults for hepatitis B.

Why?

1. Asians are 100 times more likely to have chronic hepatitis B than Caucasians (1 in 10 for Asians, 1 in 1000 for Caucasians)
2. If nothing is done, 1 in 4 Asians living with chronic hepatitis B will die from liver disease or liver cancer
3. The greatest health disparity between Asian Americans and Caucasian Americans is liver cancer
4. Due to the lack of symptoms, awareness and testing, most Asians are unaware of their infection

We're looking for people willing to learn about hepatitis B and speak at organizational meetings in San Francisco throughout the campaign. Your time commitment would be approximately one hour about every month or every other month.

Bilingual speakers (Vietnamese, Mandarin, Cantonese, Korean) are preferred, however all are welcome to be a part of this great effort!
